

# OCEAN ROUTE



## How to get to Ocean Grove leaving from downtown Victoria

1. Travel north on Trans-Canada Highway/BC-1
2. Take exit 10, following signs for View Royal/Colwood
3. Continue onto Old Island Highway S past the 6 Mile Pub and over the Parsons bridge
4. After 5-10 minutes, you'll see the Juan de Fuca Rec Centre on your left
5. At this point you have two route options to get to Ocean Grove; Ocean Route or Urban Route

## OCEAN ROUTE

- Just past the Juan de Fuca Rec Centre, take a left onto Ocean Blvd.
- Shortly after turning you'll come to a fork. Stay left to continue on Ocean Blvd.
- Follow the road down the hill as it takes you past the national historic sites of Fort Rodd Hill and the Fisgard Lighthouse
- Enjoy as the forested road opens up onto a beautiful peninsula. Take in the views as you drive past the migratory bird sanctuary on your right, part of the Esquimalt lagoon, and the open ocean on your left.

- As you continue along the peninsula, you will also notice on your right the stunning view of Royal Roads University grounds and Hatley Castle. The first intersection you come to at the end of the peninsula is Lagoon Road. Turn Right.
- Your next turn will be a right onto Heatherbell Road, followed by another right onto Seafeld and one final right turn onto Selleck Way.
